CHARLES WILLIAM ADDERTON 1866-1944

Adderton was a landscape painter and yachtsman born in Nottingham. He attended Scarborough School of Art, studying under Albert Strange, and became an accomplished watercolourist. He began exhibiting near Derby in 1884. Briefly, in 1894, he worked from a Scarborough studio but by 1929 he was living in Robin Hood's Bay where he was a member of the Fylingdales Group until 1937. Seven of his works were exhibited in the Royal Academy.
